

## **Welding Skill Development Training programme**

We are happy to inform that Welding Research Institute, Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Tiruchirappalli-620 014, in conjunction with the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India, is organizing a “Eight weeks” training programme for ITI-passed, unemployed young welders under the “Skill Development Training programme ” of D S T.

This programme would cover both theoretical aspects of welding required for the up-gradation of the skill of the welder along with intensive practical training in welding of plates & pipes. Compared to the regular training, the proposed programme is highly subsidised. The candidates would be given training in materials preparation, handling, cutting and welding both in Shielded Metal Arc welding and Gas Metal Arc welding processes. At the end of the training programme, the candidates would have to undergo a test in both theory and practice. On successful completion of the training, the candidates would be issued with certificate of competency in welding by WRI.

After the training, the candidate would be well prepared to meet the requirements of the industry.

Initially, it is proposed to train 150 candidates under this programme in batches about 30 candidates. Candidates who have passed ITI, not earlier than year 2000 and undergone one year Apprenticeship training in welding (NAC) are eligible to apply. Applications will be received in person from 15<sup>th</sup> March 2010 at WRI. The first batch of the programme is scheduled to begin on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

Candidates desirous of undergoing this training programme are required to submit their applications to Dy. General Manager, School of Welding, Welding Research Institute, Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Tiruchirappalli- 620 014 in the enclosed format. Selected candidates will be required to pay a sum of Rs.5,000 + Service Taxes as per Govt. of India rules through a demand draft drawn in favour of “Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited – Tiruchirappalli-14” and will be governed by the rules framed for the programme.
